### Description and Details

Bishop International Airport Authority Department of Public Safety is accepting applications to fill **Part-Time Public Safety Officer (PSO) III or Part Time Public Safety Officer (PSO) III Trainee** positions.

A Public Safety Officer III is responsible for the safety and security of Bishop International Airport with a focus on aircraft rescue firefighting, law enforcement, and emergency medical services.

To be eligible for the PSO III Trainee vacancy, a candidate must hold one (1) of the following credentials:

- Certified (MCOLES) Michigan Law Enforcement Officer; or
- Michigan Fire Fighters Training Council Certified Firefighter I & II.

A Public Safety Officer III Trainee will progress to become a PSO III upon the following:

- Successful completion of the probationary period;
- Completion of training of the remaining credential (Certified Law Enforcement Officer or Firefighter I & II);
- Completion of Federal Aviation Administration-approved Aircraft Rescue Fire Fighting training; and
- Completion of CPR and EMS training with a minimum of Emergency Medical Technician – Basic (EMT-B) certification.

All training must be completed within twelve (12) months of hire. Failure to complete training identified above to progress to a PSO III within twelve (12) months of hire constitutes just cause for the dismissal of a PSO III Trainee.

The Part-Time PSO III or PSO III Trainee will be scheduled for 8-hour shifts on either first, second or third shift depending upon department. Full-Time Public Safety Officers work 24 hours rotations. All applicants must satisfactorily pass oral interviews, a physical exam with drug test, a knowledge exam, and a thorough background investigation in order to be considered for employment.

Preference will be given to applicants who have already obtained Certified Law Enforcement, Firefighting I & II, and EMT-B certification; or a combination of these credentials.
