

PUBLIC NOTICE

Pursuant to Act 267 of the Public Acts of 1976, notice is hereby given that there will be a regular meeting of the Airport Authority Board on **Tuesday, April 27, 2021 at 11:30 AM.**

The purpose of the meeting is general Authority Business.

In order to mitigate the spread of COVID-19, to protect the public health and provide essential protections to vulnerable citizens, it is crucial that all citizens take steps to limit in-person contact. These critical mitigation measures include social distancing and limiting the number of people interacting at public meetings. Further, there is a local State of Emergency for the County of Genesee as declared by the Genesee County Board of Commissioners as a result of the global pandemic. Pursuant to Section 3(a) of the Open Meeting Act, a local State of Emergency is an allowable circumstance to convene electronic meetings. Therefore, the Bishop International Airport Authority will conduct all Committee and Board Meetings electronically until further notice, but not to exceed the existence of the local State of Emergency and not beyond December 31, 2021.

At the end of two minutes, the line will be disconnected.
- After the telephonic speakers are finished, e-mailed public comments will be read by staff
