Sealed bids will be received by the **Bishop International Airport Authority**, at the Administration Office until 10:00 a.m. (local time), on the bid date, at which time and place all bids will be publicly opened and read aloud. **ANY BID RECEIVED AFTER THE SPECIFIED TIME WILL NOT BE CONSIDERED.**

The proposed Work includes the following: **Security and wildlife fencing improvements, including new chain link fence, buried chain link fence skirt, repair and improvement of existing chain link fence, and security access gate replacements. Work also includes clearing & grubbing, taxiway pavement removal, airfield electrical removal and installation, and airfield drainage improvements.**

Bidder Qualifications

Prime bidder must be prequalified with MDOT. The classification required for this project is 4000 Ea (Grading, Drainage Structures, and Aggregate Construction). In addition, this project includes a specialty item classification of L (Electrical Construction). If the prime bidder is not prequalified in this specialty item classification, then it must use a subcontractor that is prequalified in classification L. This subcontractor must be designated prior to award of the contract to the confirmed low bidder.
