Pursuant to Act 267 of the Public Acts of 1976, notice is hereby given that there will be a regular meeting of the Airport Authority Board on **WEDNESDAY, December 16, 2020 at 11:30 AM.**

These critical mitigation measures include social distancing and limiting the number of people interacting at public meetings. Governor Gretchen Whitmer signed Act 228 of 2020, effective October 16, 2020, allowing remote participation in public meetings and hearings for public bodies subject to the Open Meetings Act.

- After the telephonic speakers are finished, e-mailed public comments will be read by staff
