PROJECT DESCRIPTION: **Rehabilitate Apron – Cargo, Rehabilitate Apron – Terminal,
Rehabilitate Apron – RON, Seal Apron Pavement
Surface/Pavement Joints – Deicing**

Sealed bids will be received by the **Bishop International Airport Authority**, at the Administration Office until 11:00 A.M. (local time), on the bid date, at which time and place all bids will be publicly opened and read aloud. **ANY BID RECEIVED AFTER THE SPECIFIED TIME WILL NOT BE CONSIDERED.**

The proposed Work includes the following:

- Construction of a new temporary access taxiway asphalt pavement section (earthwork, drainage improvements, electrical modifications, paving of approx. 1,090 tons of asphalt, restoration)
- Rehabilitation of the Airport’s concrete aprons, include approx. 7,900 syd. of concrete panels replacements, CTB and asphalt base repairs, spall repairs, misc. crack and joints repairs, and pavement markings.

Bidder Qualifications

Prime Bidder must be prequalified with MDOT. The net classification required for this project is 4000 B (Concrete Pavement). In addition, this project also includes designated item classifications Cb (Hot Mix Asphalt/Bituminous Paving), Ea (Grading, Drainage Structures & Agg. Cons), and L (Electrical Construction). If the prime bidder is not prequalified in these additional item classifications, then it must use prequalified subcontractors. The subcontractors must be designated prior to award of the contract to the confirmed low bidder.

There is a Disadvantage Business Enterprise (DBE) participation goal of 5.00% for this project.
