Description and Details

Bishop International Airport Authority Department of Public Safety is accepting applications to fill **Part-Time Public Safety Officer (PSO) III** positions.

A Public Safety Officer III is responsible for the safety and security of Bishop International Airport with a focus on aircraft rescue firefighting, law enforcement, and emergency medical services.

To be eligible for the PSO III vacancy, a candidate must hold the following credentials:

- Emergency Medical Technician Basic (EMT-B) certification;
- Certified (MCOLES) Michigan Law Enforcement Officer; and
- Michigan Fire Fighters Training Council Certified Firefighter I & II.

A Public Safety Officer III must have or complete the following training:

• Completion of Federal Aviation Administration-approved Aircraft Rescue Fire Fighting training; and

All training must be completed within twelve (12) months of hire. Failure to complete training identified above within twelve (12) months of hire constitutes just cause for the dismissal of a PSO III.

The Part-Time PSO III will be scheduled for 8-hour shifts on either first, second or third shift depending upon department. Full-Time Public Safety Officers work 24 hours rotations. All applicants must satisfactorily pass oral interviews, a physical exam with drug test, a knowledge exam, and a thorough background investigation in order to be considered for employment.
